

BACHELOR'S DEGREE PLACEMENT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, NEW ERA EDUCATION INVESTMENT CO. (NEEI) is an international educational placement and employment agency that specializes in assisting international student seeking financial aid and “work-study” programs in the U.S., which provides the legal right for its students to engage in legal paid Curricular Practical Training (CPT) with American companies, and

Whereas, _____, (Candidate) is a resident of the country of _____ and wishes to engage the services of NEEI to assist him/her in attaining enrollment in such a “work-study” program in addition to receive financial aid, the parties agree as follows:

(1) NEEI AND ITS AUTHORIZED AGENCIES WILL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING SERVICES:

- Assistance in selecting the appropriate university, which offers the major and degree sought by the candidate.
- Use its best effort to guarantee that the applicant in the first school year will receive the secured package financial aid from the university and from the US business group with the total funding (Adam scholarship, housing allowance & possible multicultural grant, etc.) about \$7,000 based on the 30 credits course load. The amount of awarding since the second year will depend on the GPA of individual student.
- Assistance in selecting the appropriate university for the candidate which offers paid CPT (curricular practical training), which will be at least two years long, whereby the earning can be used by the students to help pay their tuition and living. CPT could be part-time when school is in session and full-time during the summer.
- Assistance in preparing application documents and submitting required documents to the selected university
- Advocacy with Admission Department regarding acceptance of candidate’s application and rapid I-20 issuance
- Free tuition to an on-line course for international applicants preparing for visa interview (value \$1,000)
- Assistance with SEVIS registration, embassy visa reservations and consultancy on all related “work-study” issues

- Assistance with travel bookings, as necessary
- Assistance with airport pick up, as necessary
- Assistance with housing issues upon arrival, as needed
- Guarantee of legal right to paid employment if candidate is accepted into a “work-study” program referred by NEEI
- Assistance in obtaining a Social Security number granting candidate legal employment status
- Guarantee of at least an entry level job which will pay wages equal to what is paid to American employee at the same level
- Guarantee that candidate will have the right to move from an entry level job to a higher paying job at any time

(2) CANDIDATE PROMISES AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

- For the above services, candidate will pay NEEI of US\$3,500, a deposit payment should be made to an agency authorized by NEEI at student’s home country, or a deposit should be put into a bank arranged by the local agency. Deposit must be made before receiving the I-20.
- In addition to the \$3,500 NEEI service fee, candidate will pay to the university all tuition and fees as required.
- Candidate will abide by all rules and regulations of the university and of the workplace environment.

(3) FUTHER UNDERSTANDINGS:

- Only NEEI is authorized by its partner “work-study” school to accept applications and inquiries.
- NEEI has the exclusive right to give the order for “work-study” authorization only for those students who have paid \$3,500.
- Initial entry level jobs pay \$8 to \$10 per hour; higher wages are paid according to candidates’ skills and abilities.
- The \$3,500 above is a fee only for NEEI and its services, none of which is a deposit for school tuition or fees and none of which is for any other fees, including, but not limited to, medical insurance or rent.
- Candidate may choose to work either part time (20 hours per week) or full time (40 hours per week in summer).
- If candidate does not obtain a visa for the selected “work-study” program, no fee will be charged by NEEI, deposit will be fully refunded.
